



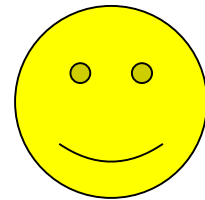

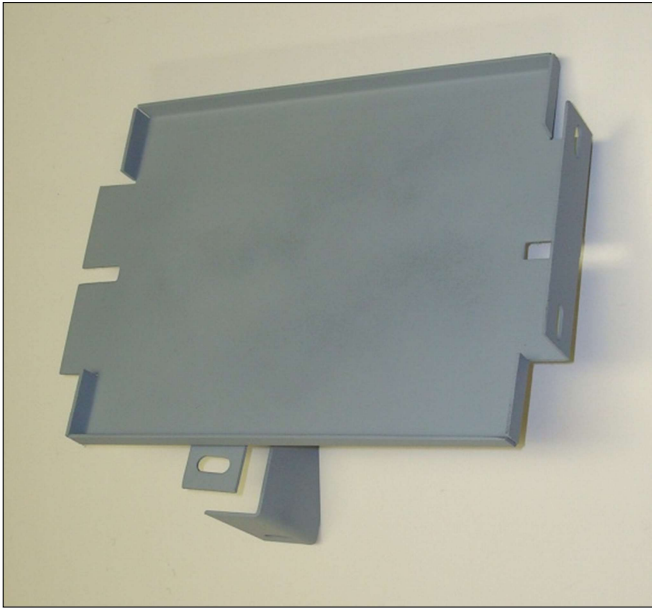

The gas tank is made of galvanized steel and made exactly like the original. The 2 wood spacer boards were originally used and are included with the tank.

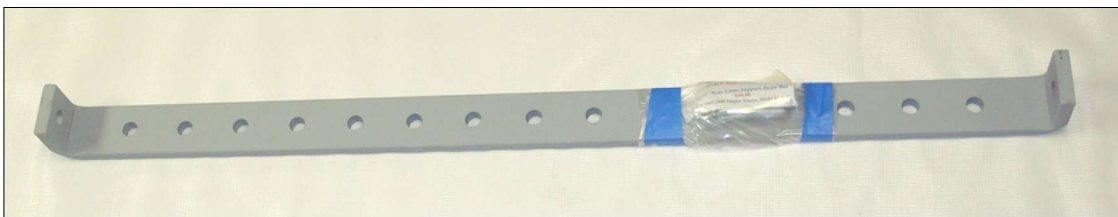
E-139 Gas Tank Valve

E-151 Draw Bar w/welded Support Guide

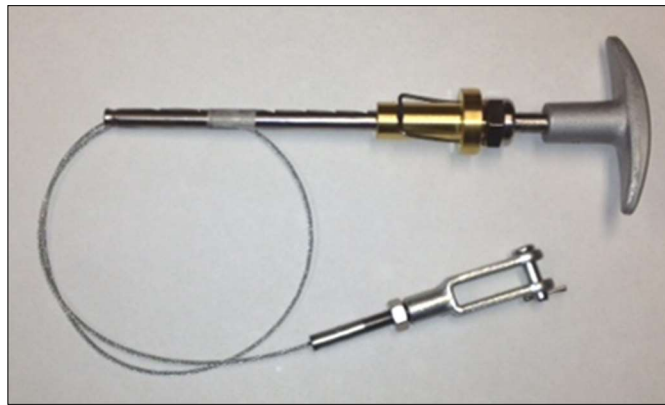


E-142 Empire Tractor Deck kit, Model 90
